
SUBJECT: Notification of AHERA inspection (or reinspection)

As required by the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) of 1986, all DoDEA buildings must be inspected for asbestos-containing materials (ACM) and an Asbestos Management Plan will be prepared if ACM has been identified. The most recent inspection was conducted on 1/18/2006 in accordance with United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) regulations and DoDEA policy. The results of the inspection or reinspection indicates that Heidelberg High School has the following asbestos materials in the school. A periodic surveillance program is in effect to monitor the condition of any asbestos remaining in the school, as required by the US EPA.
