Meeting Start: 15:30

Principal presided over meeting. Reviewed the agenda. Introduced Student Representative (Executive Council President).

Student Representative: Student Government doing well. Has organized many events such as Student Orientation, BBQ for newcomers, Homecoming, winter formal, pep rallies. Noted that school is going well. Does not like underclassman going to Campbell during lunch. Working on a project to match kids to new kids in Student2Student group using a web based database. SLO stated that they could be a model program and discussed possibilities for nominating themselves for an award.

Round Robin Introductions

PTSO Report. SH noted that PTSO is given a room this year and that they have posted comment boxes in several areas of the school. Fundraising is going well. Board is very productive. PTSO has e-mail and website. SLO would like numbers on volunteer hours to recognize them. SLO noted that VEMA (sp) is not functioning at a level for all to use easily and so until it is fixed, he will be logging data.

Booster Report: CR noted that they currently have 122 members, pay for busses and Refs. They are raising money with lunches twice a month. Noted donation by Girls Basketball team of \$800 to Haiti.

Kids seem to be lacking motivation. AdvancED visit coming up next year. HHS represented on Super bowl. General Brown coming to HHS for a commercial. Kiosk is running everyday. JAAM has a performance coming up. Almost 80 kids working outside the building in CWP. Staffing: Down on paper 2 teachers, but none will be excessed. Vice Principal spoke to discipline problems declining and using IDEA model in many areas of school.

MH noted that smoking is not happening anywhere except next to the gate. USAG noted she will continue to send MP's.

JH suggested that issues such as smoking, discipline and other problems the school is having should be taken to student government to try to solve.
